3-5-3 Unlawful Acts

3-5-1 CONTRACT FOR FIRE PROTECTION. The City of Rockwell shall provide for fire protection for the City by executing a contract as provided by law with Rockwell Community Fire Service, Inc. to provide said fire protection to the City. The City Council shall designate two persons to serve on the Board of Directors of Rockwell Community Fire Service, Inc. as representatives of the City in accordance with its bylaws.

3-5-2 RIGHT-OF-WAY. Fire equipment shall have the right-of-way on all streets in going to a fire, and all obstructing vehicles shall immediately draw up to the curb or side of the street until after the fire equipment has passed.

3-5-3 UNLAWFUL ACTS. It shall be unlawful:

1. To hinder or interfere with any officer or fireman in the performance of his duties as a member of the fire department;
2. For any person to refuse to assist in hauling or carrying any fire equipment to a fire;
3. To park or leave standing any vehicle in front of the fire department building, or on either side of the street, or within twenty feet of such building;
4. To cut, deface, destroy or injure any property or fixtures belonging to or connected with the fire department or the fire alarm system, or give or make, or cause to be given or made, any false alarm of fire.
